

CONTRACT FOR WATER SERVICES

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into on this the _____ day of _____ between:

Party of the FIRST PART, and WEBSTER COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, Webster County Kentucky party of the SECOND PART:

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the payment of a tap-on fee and the further payment of regular monthly charges of the Second Party, First Party does hereby covenant and agree to connect to the Webster County Water District.

Failure on the part of the First Party to abide by the rules and regulations of the Webster County Water District or failure to pay the monthly charges shall result in the termination of the First Party's water service. If thereafter, First Party desires to again become a customer of the Webster County Water District, he/she shall be required to pay all outstanding charges, including late fees and a re-connect fee.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the Second Part reserves the right to determine the size of service connection to be used to supply water to the party of the First Part. A 3/4" x 5/8" meter will be used unless the party of the First Part contracts for a larger meter. A tap-on fee for each 3/4" x 5/8" connection in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be paid by the party of the First Part to the party of the Second Part. The part of the Second Part agrees to install a 3/4" x 5/8" meter on the property of the First Part six feet from the road right-of-way. If farther, an additional fee will be charged.

A reasonable water rate as approved by Public Service Commission will be charged. The Webster County Water District reserves the right to file litigation for uncollected accounts and parties of the First Part may be required to pay court costs in addition to the amount of the outstanding accounts.

The party of the First Part agrees to permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, remove and disconnect lines, meters and read meters at a point on customer's property designated by the District for each signed connection with right of ingress and egress for these purposes over customer's property. Note: A separate meter must be installed for each residence.

The party of the First Part shall be responsible for the installation and maintenance at his own expense of his service line from the Webster County Water District meter to the dwelling or place of business and other portion of his premises.

The signing of this CONTRACT by a duly authorized representative of the Webster County Water District and said execution thereof is in his/her official capacity only, and said representatives shall not be personally liable on this contract.

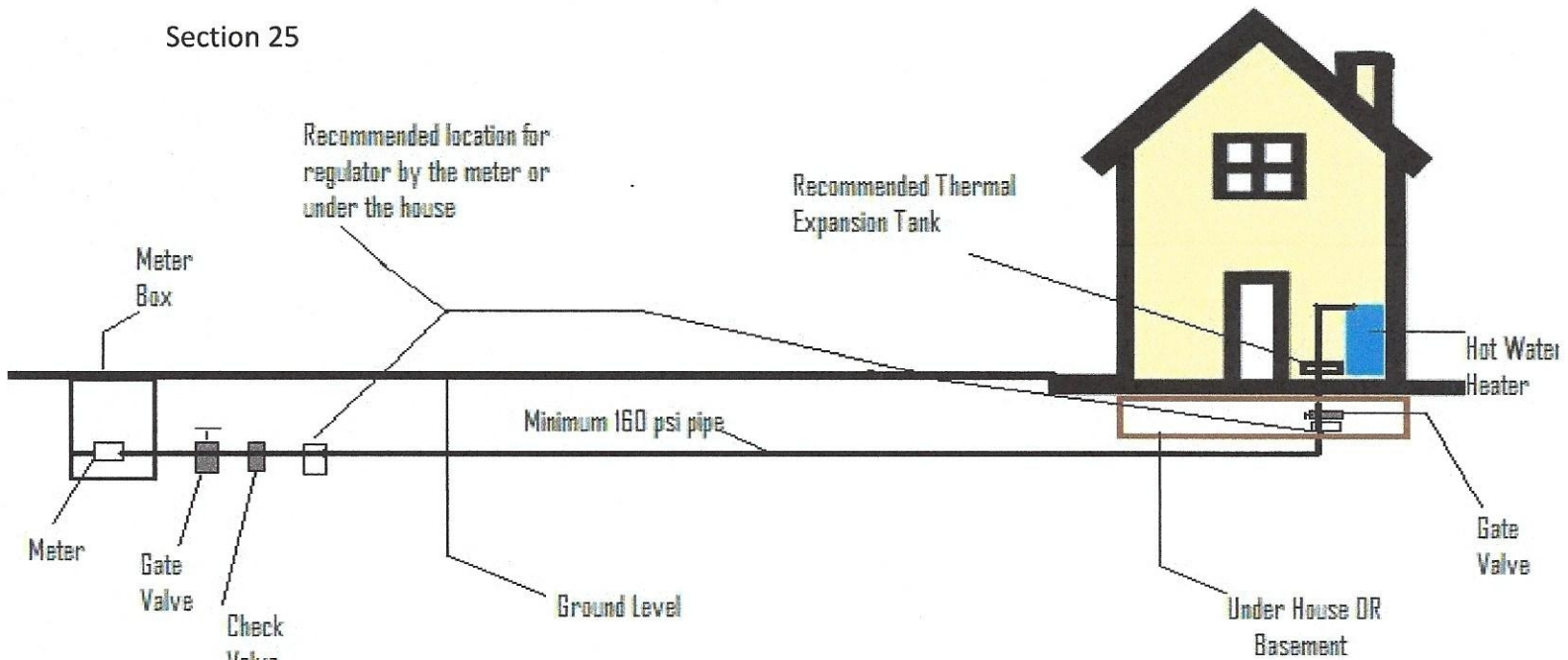

Tap-On Requirements

1. A **minimum of 160 psi pipe**.
2. **Two Gate Valves** – one directly following meter service and one at the entry point of the residence
3. **One Check Valve** – directly following gate valve at the meter box.
4. **No Cross Connection** – the water line cannot be connected to the water line that is connected to the well or previous water supply. The water line from your previous water supply must be cut into and have a gap between the two separate water supplies *twice* the diameter of the pipe.
5. Either a **Plumbing Permit** (less than 10 acres) *or* **Farm Exempt** (10 acres or more) **Permit** is required. Permits may be obtained through the Plumbing Inspector only on **Tuesdays from 8 – 9:30 a.m.** at the Webster County Health Department.
6. **Inspection** – the water line should not be covered up. The Water District and the Plumbing Inspector must inspect all connections.

Optional Recommendations

1. **Pressure Regulator** – most areas will need a pressure regulator to lower the pressure going into the residence. However some areas will have lower pressure on the Water District's line and will not need a pressure regulator. As the Water District what your pressure will be and if you will need a regulator. The regulator can be put anywhere.
2. **Thermal Expansion Tank** – some residences will experience high-pressure problems resulting from the hot water heater. A thermal expansion tank absorbs the pressure keeping the water heater and line from bursting.

Once the District has set your meter box and you have completed the above, call the office at 639-9010 and tell the staff you are ready for your meter to be set.
